

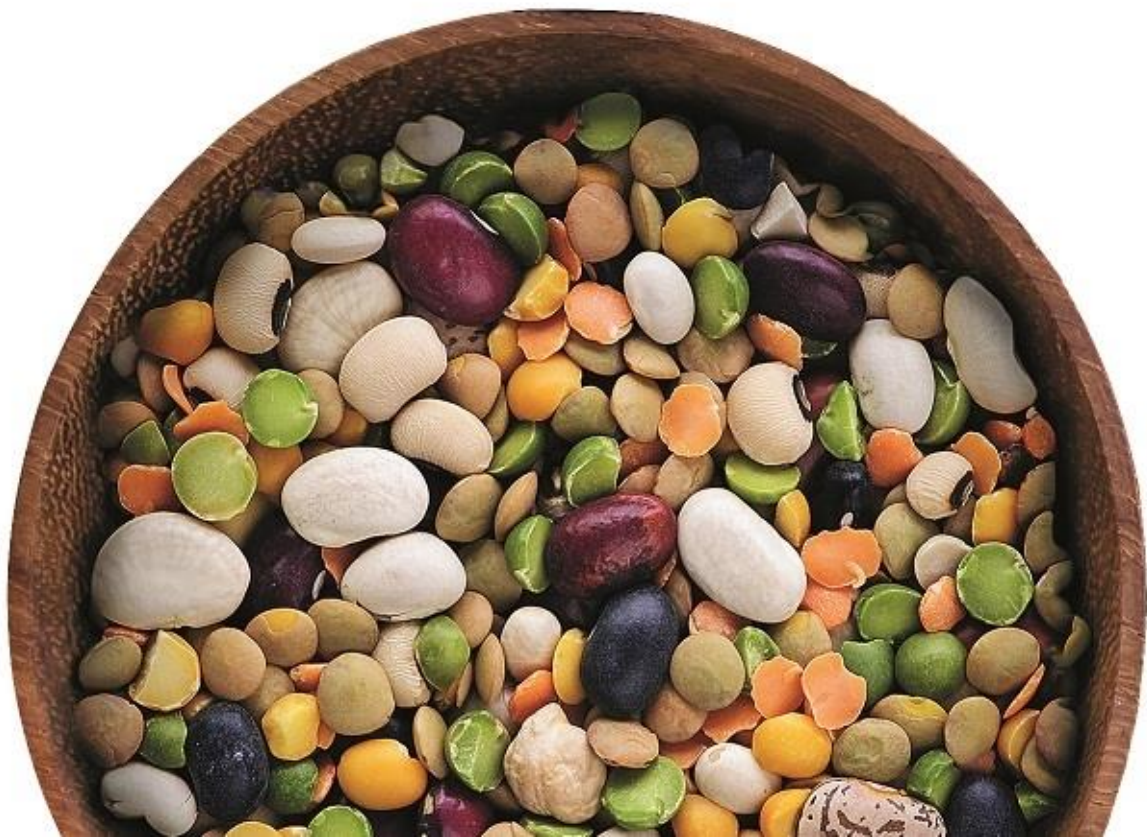

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Summary

The second year of knowledge exchange and communication activities from the TRUE project has produced numerous and varied outputs. The resources generated include many practice-based articles, notes in media targeted to the general public and other non-scientific articles targeted the trade- and press. Scientific outputs included presentations (many of which were invited), conference abstracts and posters, and articles in peer-reviewed scientific journals. Outputs also extended to press releases, blog-posts, newsletters and other social-media contributions (*e.g.* Facebook, Twitter and Vimeo). TRUE also made significant contributions (as invited experts) to key events aimed at directing governance and policy initiatives such contributions to the content and launch of the European Commission's 'Plant Protein Plan for Europe', and other reports informing policies at national levels (*e.g.* the Scottish, Hungarian and Croatian governments and regional authorities). Impactful regional outreach was also provided using TRUEs second year of European Legume Innovation Network (ELIN) workshops.

This report therefore provided details of the following: six peer-reviewed manuscripts; seven other non-peer-reviewed scientific publications; 66 oral presentations; 10 poster presentations; 22 TRUE blog posts; seven press releases; eight, publicly available Deliverables, including 19 Practice Abstracts; resources used for and generated by two ELIN workshops (in Athens Greece, and Budapest Hungary). High-level consultancies were also provided by many TRUE partners to wide range of companies from across the world and whose sizes range from micro-SMEs to large multi-national companies. Their common aim was to market a wide diversity of legume-based or -focused products across all the supply chain sectors. These consultancies are not listed here for reasons of commercial sensitivity, but we can confirm there were 27 such activities.
